Jr. Flips, LLC is an international brand of young real estate entrepreneurs consisting of **Alianna Hines** – the founder and CEO, aka the "Boss"; **Dominic Hines** – the Co-CEO, aka "Mr. Interior Design"; **Skyler Hines** – the "Brains" of the operations; **Shaun Hines** – the "Accountant"; **Neko Hines** – the "Assistant"; and **Mecca Hines** – "Miss Interior Design." These siblings and cousins are guided in business by their parents. Monique Hines, serves as a mentor, developer, real estate agent, publicist, and manager for the children.

The mission of Jr. Flips is to build 100 homes for 100 families around the world. In support of that effort, Alianna recently traveled to Ghana to tour prospective properties and land for retail development.

These fourth-generation entrepreneurs were inspired to start their own business in 2017 after meeting Oprah Winfrey. They received a loan from a relative to purchase their first property. Since then, under the guidance of skilled real estate developers, these kids have learned how to renovate old houses and sell them for a profit. Each child is involved throughout the entire process, from buying a fixer-upper, rehabbing the property, and selling it for more than they originally invested. Their specialty is doing cosmetic renovations.

Jr. Flips has renovated and sold properties in Washington, D.C., Maryland, and Virginia. These children venture far beyond the lemonade stand. They manage staff, meet celebrities, travel the world, and are moguls in the making.
